The online course is expertly designed to facilitate engagement with quality resources and up-to-date study material.

The final schedule of the live sessions will be communicated to course participants, who are encouraged to request professional development leave for the duration of the course from their employers.

Overview

Duration: 3 days

Study method: online

Language: English, more languages in planning

Workload: 12 hours (including nine 45-minute live sessions and four 1-hour clinics)

All live sessions will be recorded and made available to registered participants on the course platform. To obtain the certificate participants need to attend a minimum of 3 live sessions distributed over the three days. Course work related to the proposed schedule, provided that all work is completed submitted on the third day.

Participants will be offered time to elaborate a self-guided study on a topic of their choice in relation to themes studied in the 9 live programme units. The course instructor will provide appropriate guidance and supervision. The objective is to conduct the self-guided project throughout the three course days, completing on the third day.

The World Class on Economic, Social and Ecological Ethics focuses on the acquisition of knowledge, competences and skills in the area of sustainable development. The United Nations' Sustainable Development Goals are used as the underlying

rationale to analyse the connection between sustainable patterns of production and consumption, care for the environment, wealth distribution, responsible governance and societal participation.

Upon completion of the World Class, you will be able to understand the concept of sustainability as an ethical lens for the study of contemporary challenges; evaluate how economic, social and ecological dimensions inform the international agenda of sustainable development; classify economic, social and ecological measures within a framework of a sustainable transition process, and create a concept for a sustainable transition applicable to your own professional context.

The World Class on Economic, Social and Ecological Ethics was developed by Dr Haluk Haksal, an experienced economist, specialised in sustainability management and sustainable finance.

The course is currently taught by José Antonio David, consultant and specialist in responsible environmental and social risk management for financial intermediation operations and an experienced teacher.
